The Reverend Chris Brice is Chair of the London Churches Refugee Fund, set up in 2007 at the request of a network of refugee charities in London. LCRF is an ecumenical Christian-based organisation and inspired by the gospel, but support the relief of destitution among refugees regardless of creed or colour. The London Churches Refugee Fund (LCRF) enables churches and individuals to donate to multiple charities helping destitute refugees and asylum seekers in London. Donations are used to offer grants to front-line projects, typically for phone credit, hygiene items, food or fares to access drop-ins, language classes, solicitors, etc
